

## 32-3142: ZMCK2a Recombinant Protein

**Alternative Name :** Casein kinase II subunit alpha, EC 2.7.11.1, CK II, CK2-alpha, CK2?

### Description

Source : Escherichia Coli. Casein Kinase 2 alpha Zea Mays Recombinant is a non-glycosylated polypeptide having a molecular mass of 39.2 kDa. Casein Kinase 2 is purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques. The Casein kinase 2 (EC2.7.11.1) is a serine/threonine-selective protein kinase that is a tetramer of two alpha subunits and two beta subunits. The alpha subunits have the catalytic kinase domain. Casein kinase 2 has been implicated in cell cycle control, DNA repair, regulation of the circadian rhythm and other cellular processes. Casein kinase 2 activity has been reported to be activated following Wnt signaling pathway activation. A Pertussis toxin-sensitive G protein and Dishevelled appear to be an intermediary between Wnt-mediated activation of the Frizzled receptor and activation of casein kinase 2.

<b>Purification :</b>	Greater than 99% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
<b>Content :</b>	CK2a is supplied in 50% glycerol.
<b>Storage condition :</b>	Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time. Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
