Application Note

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Hepatocyte Growth Factor in 50mM acetic acid to a concentration not less than $100 \text{\^A} \mu \text{g/ml}$. Further dilutions should be made using buffer containing protein. The activity was assayed for scattering activity in the MDCK cell assay. The ED50 for this effect is typically at 1.0-5.0 ng/ml (200,000-1,000,000 IU/mg).
